The NHAPL strives to best serve the Landmen in our region where we work and live. We are a local affiliate of the AAPL and work in close relation to the actions and policies at a national level.

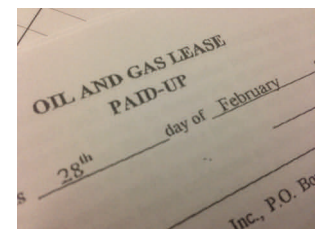
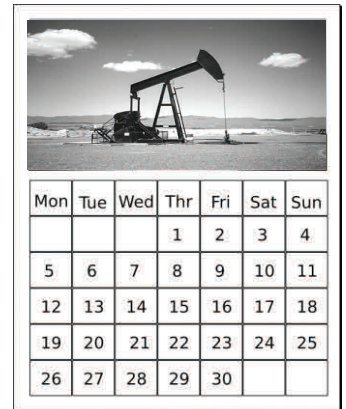
